Days of Caring

Clothing for Kids Closests

Goose Creek ISD, Barbers Hill ISD, Anahuac ISD, and East Chambers ISD now have access to school appropriate clothing and basic hygiene items for students. Your United Way has been able to provide clothing, shoes, and basic hygiene items to 34 students and their families during their time of need.

Hope for the Homeless

1200 outreach packages have gone to first responders, resource providers, and directly into the hands of those experiencing homelessness. Donors and volunteers are helping provide essential items such as basic clothing, soap, dental care items, and so much more to the vulnerable in our community!

Little Free Libraries
