The Bridge Over Trouble Waters

Being a victim of domestic violence can be devastating, but there is hope. Recently, a 37-year-old pregnant woman experiencing physical and verbal abuse by her boyfriend found her way to The Bridge. There she was told that she has rights as a victim. The Baytown Advocate was able to advocate for these rights within law enforcement, the education system and other community services. The client was assisted with many programs specifically for victims of abuse including medical services. She was provided peer support to empower her to make the decisions that were right for her and her family. After escaping the abusive relationship she found herself unable to pay her rent. Like many victims, the abuser was the main source of income. With The Bridge's support she secured a job at a local restaurant.



The Bridge Over Troubled Waters provides their clients with referrals to legal programs, free counseling sessions, support groups and financial education in addition to immediate help such as food and toiletries.
